Minutes of March 19, 2009 General Meeting

Jack Blocker moved, and Doug Mackenzie seconded, a motion to approve the minutes as distributed. **Approved.**

Sailing School Report

Peter Wilkins reported that little had changed since his report for the *Scuttlebutt*. Letters of appointment for the instructor staff will be mailed soon.

Preparations for Sailing Season

Fleet Captain Rick Goldt reported that repair work has been done on the Main Dock; asphaltting will be done within the next 2-3 weeks after the fill has had a chance to settle. Asphaltting will probably be added to the foot of the ramp to the Main Dock.

Rear Commodore Doug Carey reported that the notice for the June Bug Regatta has been circulated, on the FYC website and to other sailing clubs. Arrangements are underway to give boat rides to children enrolled in the Big Brothers and Big Sisters programs; a final announcement of a suitable date will be made.

Commodore Mark Anderson outlined plans to offer boat rides to adult Sailing School graduates after completion of their courses. After discussion, there was general support for the idea. After general discussion of a proposed financial incentive to attract adult Sailing School graduates to Club membership, a motion was proposed (Blocker, Morris): To waive the \$100 initiation fee for adult Sailing School graduates of the current or previous year. After discussion, the mover and seconder agreed to amend the motion to read: To waive the \$100 initiation fee for adult Sailing School graduates *and leasing members* of the current or previous year. **Approved.**

Membership Secretary Nina Myers reported that we currently have 82 members, nine fewer than last year at this time. (report on file)
